The following topics were discussed during the conference call:

- Target young boys at risk of dropping out
- Elementary through high school
- Each school has a site director (provided a supplement)
- Begin to recruit male mentors (fraternities, police, firefighters, judges, prosecutors' offices, doctors, colleges and universities). Students were given a pledge.
- Students were given a distinctive uniform (a tie with the emblem)
- The school site has to be sensitized to the "boys of color."
- District 3 full-time people funding for stipends, field trips 5 personnel; 600,000-800,000 approximately
- Field trips during the school day jail, parks, attractions, etc.
- Activities induction ceremonies, tie tying celebrations
- Pursue funding from the Council of Great City Schools (Executive Board Meeting will be in Jacksonville in January)
- Approach Blue Cross/Blue Shield and foundations for funding
- Have restitution paid to the program
- Have Congresswoman Wilson come and swear them in.
