- Currently in Miami Dade, the program serves approximately 8000 students in 101 schools, including 32 elementary, 34 middle and K-8 Centers, and all high schools.
- It appears as if the funding is paid through the district. However, we know there are no private funds used for scholarships and additional field trips.
- John Sullivan, Lobbyist for Duval County, is working with key legislators to earmark funding for Duval in the amount of \$250K to establish the program next year.
- Larry Roziers, Executive Director, Family and Community Engagement, visited Miami-Dade to observe and understand the program. Our initial thought is to identify the following schools to start the program next year:
